The Aspendos Theatre, built in the 2nd century AD, is a well-preserved Roman theater known for its architecture and acoustics, seating up to 15,000 spectators. It remains a popular site for tourists and cultural events. Side, an ancient port city in Pamphylia, dates back to the 8th century BC. Visitors can explore ruins like city walls, a theater, and temples to Apollo and Athena. Side's historical sites and beaches make it a favorite for tourists. Manavgat Waterfall, is one of the widest river around Antalya and its very popular spot. Nowadays people take a boat tour on it to have fishing and enjoying.
